# **Guidelines** Issued by the Albert Heim Foundation

# for submission of an application for support for cynological research projects

#### 1. Basic principles:

- 1.1. The Albert Heim Foundation (hereinafter referred to as AHS) supports academic research in the area of cynology, makes cynological knowledge available and promotes the dissemination of knowledge acquired (Art. 3 of the Statutes). The Foundation Board is responsible in this respect (Art. 5), with the Secretary's Office supporting the operational implementation.
- 1.2. The submission of applications requesting support is open to any individual in principle. As a rule, however, preference is given to university academic work.
- **1.3.** Submission of a detailed application with as much complete information as possible facilitates an objective review.

#### 2. Dates and administrative provisions:

- 2.1. The submission dates for applications (to the Secretary's Office) are **1 March** and **1 September** of the current year.
- 2.2. Submissions must be addressed to the Chairman of the AHS in electronic form with a copy submitted to the Secretary's Office.
- 2.3. The application must be submitted by the applicant personally and signed by the applicant and any co-applicants.

## 3. Requirements for submitted project outlines and applications for support:

- 3.1. The project outline must have a meaningful title that is formulated such that the specific characteristics of the planned research work are clear. The application must also include:
- 3.2. a short statement detailing the current state of research in the planned area of work: previous findings, starting position, existing gaps in knowledge, references to other research work in the same subject area;
- 3.3. a short statement detailing the current position of the applicant's own research (incl. CV and list of publications, as relevant): reference to work personally undertaken in the current subject area, indication of any international collaboration etc.;
- 3.4. a detailed research plan (incl. schedule and budget); this should explicitly detail the contribution expected from the AHS and what this will be used for;
- 3.5. description of concrete, feasible goals of the research work in the period covered by the submission; specification of the materials and methods required to achieve these goals;
- 3.6. an evaluation of the significance of the results expected and their implications for the future;
- 3.7. a summary of the research project (summary with key words);
- 3.8. insofar as the planned research project deals with animal experimentation in line with the current legislation, a copy of the approval given by the competent authority shall be submitted with the application for support. If no animal experimentation is involved, a written confirmation to this effect shall suffice.

## 4. Further procedure following the submission of the application:

4.1. Timely submissions will be evaluated at the subsequent spring or autumn meeting of the Foundation Board;

- 4.2. The decision will be communicated to the applicant in writing;
- 4.3. If the application receives a positive response from the Foundation Board, the applicant shall receive a letter of confirmation detailing the decision (project number, member of the Foundation Board responsible), the approved level of support and conditions. The applicant shall return a signed copy to the Secretary's Office confirming acceptance and including bank account details;
- 4.4. Half (50%) of the amount approved by the Foundation Board will be paid out at the start of the project; the remaining amount will be paid on approval of the final report by the Foundation Board;
- 4.5. The Foundation Board must receive an interim report advising on the project progression annually (submission date either 1 March or 1 September);
- 4.6. An illustrated summary of the final report shall be provided in layman's terms, suitable for publication in a journal of the Swiss Cynological Society (SKG) (e.g.HUNDE);
- 4.7. Publication shall be agreed by the Foundation Board following consultation with editorial staff.

## 5. Final provisions

In case of doubt, the statutes of the AHS shall apply. These guidelines were last amended on 20 January 2015. They replace all previous versions.
